

Privacy Notice - Hampshire CAMHS

Who are we and what do we do?

Hampshire CAMHS is an NHS service for young people up to the age of 18 who are finding it hard to manage their emotional and mental health. In order to help you we have to collect some information.

Why do we do it?

For us to deliver the best care to you we will collect personal information about you.

Why are we allowed to do it?

The NHS has a duty to care for its patients, and keeping records of the care we provide helps us to do this.

Who is my information shared with?

We might share your information with other organisations involved in your care, if this would help your care.

When will my information be deleted?

Your information will be held for as long as it is needed for the purpose of your health records.

What are my rights?

You have rights around your information. If you think something isn't right or you want to understand more contact our team.
