Why are we doing this?

CAMHS recognises that now, more than ever, the mental health needs of our young people are at their most vital, with many young people struggling with mental health issues post-Covid. We are also acutely aware of the importance of staff wellbeing at this current time. Facilitated by CAMHS clinicians in partnership with Hampshire Educational Psychologists, the Mental Health Forum will openly explore these issues by employing a Whole School Approach to supporting mental health. Topics will vary each session at the request of the group and in response to emerging themes and observations that teaching staff experience.

The Mental Health Forum allows opportunities for all attendees to learn about the CAMHS offer, share resources and the offers of other local services that might be best placed to meet the mental health needs of young people. The integrity and strength of the forum relies on the active participation of education professionals. It is hoped that through participation and collaboration, education professionals will feel empowered to support one another to build knowledge, skills, and expertise. We offer Mental Health forums for Infant/Primary and Secondary schools within different areas of Hampshire, and we are also excited to introduce a County Wide Special School Mental Health forum for our special schools across Hampshire.



School nurses are invited to join the forum space to contribute their vast knowledge and experience. It is at the discretion of schools who they may choose to attend but previous participants have included LSAs, members of pastoral support team, heads of year, SENCOs and mental health leads.
